
Scratchboard Animal Portrait

Overview

Students will learn and practice the scratchboard techniques and compare value and texture in scratchboard art to what we have done in a previous pencil drawing lesson. They will choose an animal to portray, trace the photograph on the scratchboard and complete their portraits using the techniques focusing on the use of value and texture.

Objectives

Students will be able to

- Learn and explore the scratchboard techniques
- Demonstrate their understanding of texture and value in art

Activities

1. Students will learn about the scratchboard and techniques by watching the PowerPoint presentation
2. Practice the scratchboard techniques
3. Choose an animal to portray, trace the photograph on the scratchboard
4. Create scratchboard animal portrait using the techniques

Adaptations

- Students may use fewer scratchboard techniques
- Students may use smaller scratchboard

Evaluation

Students will be evaluated on the completed scratchboard animal portrait based on the rubrics
